INTERNATIONAL WOMENS DAY COMES TO MURRUMBIDGEE

Over sixty people registered to hear about local Kate O'Callaghan's leadership journey and enjoy the Murrumbidgee Council's 2018 International Women's Day Event at the Darlington Point Services Club. Murrumbidgee Council Mayor and event MC, Cr Ruth McRae, noted the day was "all about advocacy and action, unity, celebration and reflection - and what that looks like globally at a local level. So, it is not just the women within Murrumbidgee Council area who are gathering today to share a meal and celebrate the social, economic, cultural and political achievement of women, (and of course enjoy one another's company)."
