

Lions Club Grant Guidelines

Introduction

Following the closing of Lions Club Darlington Point, an amount of \$40,000 was transferred to Murrumbidgee Council to manage.

This money is to be allocated to residents or organisations within Darlington Point for the purpose of Education, Children's Aid or Community Wellbeing.

This is to be an annual fund allocation to the value of no more than \$2,000, distributed in part or in whole to Murrumbidgee Council's chosen recipients.

Eligibility

Grants of up to \$2,000 will be awarded to eligible applicants.

Who Can Apply

- Individual residents or organisations within Darlington Point.
- Individuals or organisations should provide detailed information regarding the proposed service, project or program for which funds are required.

Conditions of Grant

All successful applicants must adhere to the 'Conditions of Grants and Contributions' as outlined below:

- a) The funding amount available and eligibility are defined in operational guidelines for each grant.
- b) Funding must only be used for the purposes outlined in the offer of the grant by Council.

Important Information

Please note that an application for a grant does not necessarily result in funding or may result in only a portion of the amount requested being allocated.

All grant applications must be completed using the Lions Club Grant Application Form on Council's website or at Council Offices.

Maximum Grant

The maximum grant allocated under the Lions Club Grants Program is \$2,000.

Number of Grant Applications

Only one application will be accepted per community group/organisation for this grant.

Categories

- Education
- Children's Aid
- Community Wellbeing

To assist the assessment of all applications for the Lions Club Grant, applicants are requested to indicate on the application form one category they consider their project best fits.

This grant program is subject to an eligibility assessment by Council officers, prior to evaluation at the October meeting of Council.

The following information is presented to explain how your application will be assessed.

The information you provide in your application will be used to assess your application against the three categories listed above. Council reserves the right to consider applications in any category deemed appropriate.
