The unrelenting dry period seems to know no bounds. Our agricultural sector is now making serious decisions that vacillate between survival and break even.

These decisions of course have a compounding effect, and our small service centres are also feeling significant financial strain. Our economy is at tipping point and the well being of our communities is being sorely tested.

General Manager John Scarce, Deputy Mayor Councillor Black and I attended the Post Amalgamation Forum in Terrigal on 16-17 September, 2019.

In what was an informative forum, some stark realities were made very apparent. It would appear that the greatest impacts of forced Council amalgamations have and continue to be felt by the smaller Councils.

This was no news to us - a small Council - 3 uniquely different communities - 4000 people.

There is no rationale that stands up to genuine scrutiny. Our people - our staff and our communities - have felt the brunt of an onerous, anxious and convoluted process - there is nowhere to hide and there are too many faceless people.

A panel comprising very diverse cases certainly highlighted just how very different Local Government is in the State of NSW.

From the largest Council in NSW - Central Coast Council estimated population of 345,000 and an \$800 million budget to Murrumbidgee Council with an estimated population of 4000 and a \$10 million budget.

What was made very apparent was that the 'process' should have had a flexible and relevant template.

Workshops covering LEP's and Landuse Planning, Workforce and Systems, Local Representation and Community Engagement, and Rates Harmonisation and Finance were informative, but again they need to be pared back to grass roots to be of genuine assistance for us.

Where To From Here - It is our responsibility, as elected members, to make this work. Our Communities - our people - need us to be pro-active and not reactive. They need us to be future focused, accountable and transparent. They need us

to prioritise our service delivery of essential services/core business. They need us to work as a united team so that our Council has a future.

'Team work will make the dream work'.

September and October are incredibly busy times socially in our towns.
